We refer to our earlier Third Party Observation under Art. 115 EPC of 11 January 2013.

With this new Observation we would like to stress that **epi** agrees with the content of the Third Party Observations filed on March 28, 2013 by George Schlich and NIABA.

In particular **epi** wishes to stress that predictability and harmonization are important goals and the EPO should adopt a position in which exclusions to patentability are interpreted as narrowly as possible given the legislative intentions. The EPO is urged not to adopt a more restrictive practice than that of the German Federal Court in this matter.
